## RIDGE HILLS HOLIDAY CLINIC

The program for the clinic has been designed to introduce young players to soccer in a fun and safe environment and to help those already playing to improve their skills. The activities will cater for boys and girls whether they are playing soccer for the first time or are already keen players. Each session focuses on individual skill development and small group play. This approach to coaching has proved to be popular with both parents and children.

### WHAT DOES IT INVOLVE?

The clinic will be divided into 2 kinds of activities. The first part will be skill development activities where the student will be taught the basic skills of the game. The drills and games will help to improve ball control, 1v1 skills as well as passing and shooting technique. The second will be small sided games to provide an opportunity for the players to practice their skills in game related situations.

All coaches involved in the clinic are qualified through the national coaches education program and are experienced working with junior players.
